## RGRTA Bus Operators to Showcase Skills at Annual Bus Roadeo

Winner will have chance to continue RGRTA's success at State and International levels

Bus Operators representing RTS, Lift Line and seven regional subsidiaries will compete in the annual Rochester Genesee Regional Transportation Authority (RGRTA) Bus Roadeo, on Saturday, June 21, beginning at 8:30 a.m. in Lot G at Monroe Community College. The event features skilled drivers in a competition that tests their ability to maneuver buses as large as 40-feet and weighing 14 tons. Operators must sharply perform 15 driving maneuvers within 7 minutes or risk losing points. The marked course simulates various situations encountered on the road. A second competition is held concurrently for the smaller Lift Line and regional subsidiaries' buses.

Transit organizations throughout the United States and Canada stage annual roadeos, with local, state and international contests. The RGRTA competition will include drivers who have won at both the state and international levels. RTS Operator Richard Bastedo is a former International Roadeo winner, and Maurice Hebert won the 2012 state competition, held at the State Fairgrounds in Syracuse. This year's winner will have the opportunity to compete in the state competition, scheduled to take place in September in Albany, and the 2015 International competition, next May.
