Redesigned RTS Bus Service for Westside Communities Starts Jan. 6

Effective Jan. 6, 2014, Brockport, Spencerport, and Gates communities will have improved bus service to key educational, retail, and employment destinations via RTS' Route 20. Destinations include SUNY Brockport, Village of Spencerport, Rochester Tech Park in Gates, and the Brockport Park and Ride—located on Commencement Drive, off of Route 31 and Lake Road.

A major feature of the route will allow SUNY Brockport and Brockport Park and Ride customers to reach downtown Rochester without detouring along Ridge Road or Lake Avenue. Other highlights include seven additional trips to Rochester Tech Park and adjusted downtown arrival times in the evening—making bus transfers more convenient.
