WATS Annual Dinner Recognizes Staff Excellence

Wayne County Transportation Service exceeds expectations for year

Rochester Genesee Regional Transportation Authority (RGRTA) and Wayne Area Transportation Service (WATS) staff met for an annual recognition dinner on Thursday, Jan. 23, in Lyons, N.Y. RGRTA CEO Bill Carpenter was joined by RGRTA Commissioner Michael Jankowski, Wayne County Chairman of the Board of Supervisors James Hoffman, Marion Town Supervisor Monica Deyo, and retired Town Supervisor Jody Bender. RGRTA Director of Regional Operations Raymond P. LeChase Jr. and Director of People Traci Clark, also attended to review the year's activity and recognize employees for exceptional service.

Carpenter credited WATS Regional Manager Robert Jordan for the success of the public transit operation, which serves the residents of Wayne County. Carpenter cited increased ridership and on-time-performance as recent successes, and also attributed WATS' glowing customer satisfaction scores to the service provided by Bus Operators. He said, "Our drivers ask themselves, 'What kind of day has this person had? Is there something I can do to make them feel better?'"

In 2013, WATS entered into a partnership with the Wayne County Development Disabilities Services Office (DDSO) to provide service for DDSO clients, which helped account for a 30 percent increase in ridership.
