Take the Bus for a Buck to Frozen Frontier

Multiple bus routes to Frontier Field eliminate winter driving, parking headaches

Hockey fans headed for the “Frozen Frontier” festival can avoid the cost and hassle of parking and driving if they opt to take the bus. For \$1 per trip, fans have the option of several RTS routes which stop directly outside of Frontier Field.

RTS’s regular service to Frontier Field will be in effect during the event that runs for 10 days, from Dec. 13 through Dec. 21.

- RTS routes 20 (Brockport) and 3 (Lyell) stop directly in front of Frontier Field at the intersection of Plymouth and Morrie Silver Way.
- Routes 1 (Lake) 10 (Dewey), 14 (West Ridge Road), 15 (Latta), and 96 (Hilton/Hamlin), also stop next to the west side of Frontier Field between Commercial Street and Morrie Silver Way (adjacent to Brown Square and Erie Canal Industrial Park). The stops are a quick 2-minute walk into the stadium.
