RTS To Alter Lake Avenue Service During Roc City Rib Fest

Customer drop-off at Kodak-Eastman Loop; Connection to shuttle passengers north to Charlotte

To accommodate the expected crowds and increased traffic for the 6th Annual Roc City Rib Fest, and to minimize disruptions to the rest of the fixed service route, #1 Lake buses displaying “Lake to Charlotte” or “Lake to Kodak” will drop customers off at the Kodak- Eastman Loop, where a connection to travel further north on Lake Avenue to Charlotte will be provided at no cost. The alteration will be in effect from Friday, May 24 at 6:17 p.m. until Monday, May 27 at 11:33 p.m,

During the same time period, Route #1 buses in Charlotte will display destination signs of “Lake to Kodak” and connection service will be available at Kodak (without additional cost) to customers wishing to travel towards downtown. No buses will be able to service the Port of Rochester. Customers will need to board buses along Lake Ave.
