## Proposed Schedule Changes for the RTS Transit Center

**The beautiful new building is not all that’s changing for RTS:** we’re also proposing changing our routes and schedules. We’re doing this to accommodate the additional time required to travel through the Transit Center and to enhance the customer experience!

### Key changes would include:

- Departure times at quarter-hour increments in the evenings (e.g., 9:15 instead of 9:19; 10:30 instead of 10:26)
- 75-minute departure intervals for evenings/60-minute departure intervals for weekends
- Final departures from the Transit Center at 11:45 p.m.

### For customers, these adjustments will make service:

- Easier to remember
- Simpler and more straightforward
- Convenient – with plenty of time to make transfers to the next bus
